Year 4	Salad dressing or long life milk/custard
Year 5	Soft drink or non-perishable juice
Year 6	Coffee/Tea/Milo/Quick, etc.
Staff	Pancake or cake mixes
School Supplies (optional)	Drink Bottles, Lunch Boxes, pens, pencils, tissues, pencil cases, erasers, glue sticks or rulers.
