Dear Parents,

On Thursday 31/8/17, the students in Years K-3 will be participating in an incursion called 'Muddy Gully'. This is the incursion that was postponed last Term due to bad weather conditions. The duration of the experience will be 1.5 hours for each group and the session times will run as follows:

Session 1 ~ 9:30-10:30 = Yr2 and Yr3

Session 2 ~ 11-12:30 = PP and Yr1

Session3 ~ 1:30-3 = Kindy and Yr3

Educated by Nature's incursions are designed to connect students with the natural world through play. The incursions are also designed to empower students through the opportunity to work on skills and finding individual and collaborative success in the transformation of natural objects. Clay offers tactile experiences that engage the senses, inspire creativity and support fine and gross motor skills. This incursion gives children an opportunity to take sensory risks in a supportive environment. Sloppy, firm, gooey and muddy clay is available for small scale or full body exploration of clay in various forms. Natural ochres are provided for face painting with an indigenous connection. Water play is also an important part of this incursion -a chance to tip, pour, collect and splash.

Your child will need to come to school dressed in their uniform and then change into a set of old clothes in which they can get dirty and wet! Also, please provide your child with a towel. It's going to be very messy and lots of fun!
