4-Year Old Kindergarten Enrolment: Thank you to those families who have met with me and had their Kindergarten enrolment interview for 2018. If there are still parents who have not yet filled in an enrolment application form and dropped it into the school office, can I please ask that you do so as soon as possible. Eligible children would be born between 1 July 2013 and 30 June 2014. Families with siblings already enrolled in the school will still need to enrol their child for 4-Year Old Kindergarten.

Sacrament of Confirmation: Last Saturday evening, 12 candidates from Year 6 received the Sacrament of Confirmation. I'd like to sincerely thank Fr Tony Chiera for being the main celebrant on the night and confirming our students and to Jenny Gorman, Del Leahy, Lyn Della Franca, Fr Jay and especially Sophie Figueiredo for their dedication and assistance throughout the Sacramental programme.

Reports: On Wednesday 28 June, students in Years PP-6 will bring home their school report and sample work book for Semester One. All the children have been working extremely hard throughout the semester and have achieved some very pleasing results. Please take the time to sit down and talk through the report with your child. We are all unique and it is important not to compare your child with other children in the classroom or even with siblings. Each person has their own strengths and areas for growth. Please do not hesitate to contact your classroom teacher should you wish to meet with them following receipt of the school report. Over the next two Mondays, as part of the reporting process, Mrs Fuller will be conducting Kindy Parent-Teacher interviews. At the end of the semester, each Kindy family would have received a work sample portfolio and had an interview with Mrs Fuller regarding their child's personal and social development.

St Joseph's Waroona "Buddy Bench"

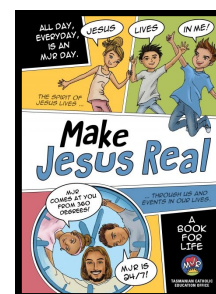

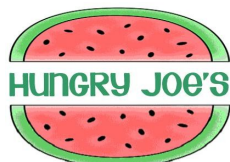

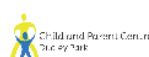
