Any attendance rate that is below 90% is classified as being at-risk. The school is currently looking closely at the attendance rates of all students from Pre Primary to Year 6. Those families whose child has been identified by the school as being at Moderate Educational Risk, will receive a letter outlining the attendance percentage for their child. Maintaining regular attendance at school not only allows a student full access to the curriculum but it gives them a best chance of success.
