Draw a picture of all the different people Jesus loved.	Jesus taught that people should be friends with everyone. Jesus taught his disciples to live in a certain way. Read the Gospel story on Activity Sheet 1 with an adult.	People follow the teachings of Jesus to treat everyone as a friend when they follow his Commandment to love one another just as he loved them. Show love to people in your family by caring for them and using manners.
Week 3 We are learning that Lent is a time to change and remember to live as Jesus taught	Lent is a special time of forty days when people remember the sacrifice that Jesus made. It starts on Ash Wednesday and finishes on Holy Thursday. Practice counting to forty using forty things from around your house.	Lent prepares Christians for the celebration of Easter. People prepare for forty days and think about how they can change their lives to live as Jesus taught. Learn the baby Shark Lent song on Activity Sheet 2.	Just as Jesus carried out actions showing love and service during his life, people carry out special actions during Lent. Trace around the outline of your foot and inside the foot, write down one kind action you will do for others during Lent.
Week 4 We are learning that Easter is a time when the Church celebrates the Resurrection of Jesus	On Easter Sunday, people go to Church to celebrate that Jesus is risen, the Resurrection. Read the Gospel story on Activity Sheet 3 with an adult. Listen to the YouTube song 'One Two Three': https://bit.ly/36gAzjH	When people go to Church on Easter Sunday, they will see the Church decorated in white to reflect the season of new life. Use Activity Sheet 4 to decorate the Church with white banners, the Easter candle, and white flowers.	The Easter candle (Paschal candle) is lit from the new fire of the Easter Vigil Mass. It is used in the Easter Season that lasts for fifty days after Easter Sunday. Watch the video of the Easter candle being lit. https://bit.ly/32b06iw
Week 5 We are learning that Christians continue to live as Easter people	Easter is a time of great joy. Jesus appeared to his disciples after the Resurrection and his first words to them were, 'Peace be with you.' Chat to a family member about what you think those words mean.	People continue to spread this peace of Jesus with others. During Mass people make the Sign of Peace. Make the Sign of Peace with someone in your family. Practice with and without a handshake. 
