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Early Years Water Fun Day

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Next Tuesday the 10th of March, the Early Learning Years (K-2) will be participating in a 'water fun day'. This day will involve a variety of water-based investigation stations and a visit from the Waroona Volunteer Fire Brigade.

The activities will consist of messy and wet play experiences that will cater to each child's sensory needs and interests. Through this play, children's imaginations can run wild whilst they make their own discoveries, stimulating their curiosity and developing their knowledge of the world around them.

We ask that your child wears clothes and a hat that you don't mind getting wet or dirty, perhaps bathers with a rashie and shorts. Your child will need to come to school with these clothes under their school sports uniform. Please ensure they are also wearing sunscreen. Please ensure that your child also has a change of underwear, socks, correct shoes and a towel.

KEY DETAILS:

Date: Tuesday 10th March

Dress: Messy and wet play clothes, hat and towel

The day will address the following outcomes from the EYLF and SCSA Curriculum.

Outcome 1 – Children Have a Strong Sense of Identity

- *Children engage in and contribute to shared play experiences. Play provides children with the opportunity to discover create, improvise and imagine. When children play they create social groups, test out ideas and build new understandings.*

Outcome 2 – Children are Connected With and Contribute to Their World

- *Children begin to broaden their understanding of the world they live in. They begin to build connections between the early childhood setting and the local community.*
- *Children become familiar with water and its uses. They begin to think about water conservation and caring for the environment.*
