This year, the school has again taken over responsibility for designing and obtaining our class leavers' shirts. The Year 6 class chose a design and we have decided to go through Fully Promoted in Mandurah to get them made (as used in previous years). Our aim is to have the shirts ready for the Year 6s to wear on the first day of Term 2. In order to do this, we need to get our order in ASAP.

I have travelled to Fully Promoted and picked up sample shirts for students to try on for size. There have been some discrepancies in sizes in previous years, so we encourage you to come in with your child to look at the shirt style and sizes available and choose a size that is 1-2 sizes larger than they would normally wear. The students grow quite a lot throughout the year, and we want to get as much wear out of them without the students feeling uncomfortable or self-conscious. These will be available in the Year 6 room before and after school on Wednesday March 8th and Thursday 9th March. If you are unable to make it in, please send me a Seesaw message and I will help your child to choose an appropriate size. I will contact you via Seesaw to let you know the size we have decided on.

There is no limit to how many shirts you can order. This can be part of your child's uniform for the remainder of the year. They will still be required to wear their faction shirt on Fridays for sport with Mrs Langan.
