CONDITIONS OF INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC APPLICATION						
1	Instrumental tuition fees will be invoiced through the College. All fees are to be finalised by the end of Term 1 unless a payment arrangement has been made with the finance department. Failure to pay your fees by the stipulated date will result in music lessons being cancelled and the full amount of music tuition being owned to the College.					
2	The Director of the Arts will exercise the right to terminate a student's instrumental tuition at any time if it is deemed that the termination will be in the best interest of the student and/or their instrumental tutor.					
The Arts Department must be notified via Direqt Message or email to ciarn.sanders@cewa.edu.au by 8.00am if the student is unable to attend their schedule lesson (this includes but is not limited to illness, assessments, excursions etc). Failure to do so will result in the full cost of the lesson being charged. Contacting only the Music Tutor to cancel a lesson or the College's Attendance Officer is not sufficient.						
4	The cost of any instrumental book(s) or external examinations recommend by the instrumental tutor must be paid for by the parent/guardian.					
5	If a student does not receive all lessons during the school year (and have followed the absentee policy), a refund or credit to College tuition for the lessons not received will be given at the end of the school year.					
6	Should the student with to cancel their music lessons, 4 weeks written notice is to be given to the Director of the Arts, Mrs Torryl Blackwell.					
7	Shared lessons are subject to availability. These cannot be guaranteed.					
8	8 This agreement is valid up until the end of 2024 only. A new application form needs to be completed for 2025.
