NAPLAN will commence for our Year 3 and 5 students from 11 May until 21st May. Our students have undertaken some preparation testing, and our 1:1 iPad program has made this process seamless and not disrupted the normal learning taking place.

In May this year, our school will be taking part in the Australian Early Development Census (AEDC). AEDC is, a nationwide census/survey of early childhood development, held once every three years. The AEDC is an Australian Government initiative run by the Department of Education, Skills and Employment and includes all children in Pre-Primary.
